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STREET LIGHTING SERVICE (7,17)

I. AVAILABILITY

Service under this rate schedule is available throughout the Cooperative's service area from existing distribution lines in accordance with the Standard Terms and Conditions for Electric Service of the Cooperative. This rate schedule is available for municipalities, road lighting districts, or others who contract for the operation of street lighting systems in incorporated cities, recognized unincorporated communities including subdivisions, or areas immediately adjacent thereto for the lighting of public streets, roads, and thoroughfares. This rate schedule is not available for individual, rural or private area lighting.

II. TYPE OF SERVICE

Unmetered high-pressure sodium, metal halide or equivalent lighting service from dusk to dawn - approximately 4,000 hours per year.

III. MONTHLY RATE

Service Charge:

100 Watt	\$ 5.62 per lamp, plus PCA and ECA for 80 kWh
250 Watt	\$10.36 per lamp, plus PCA and ECA for 116 kWh
400 Watt	\$12.80 per lamp, plus PCA and ECA for 177 kWh

The above charges include the installation, maintenance, energy supply, and control by the Cooperative of standard street light fixtures and lamps mounted on standard wooden poles.

IV. ADDITIONAL FACILITIES CHARGE

A. Where the Cooperative is required to furnish underground service to wood poles, Member may:

1. Make a lump sum payment of \$100 per light standard, or
2. Pay a monthly charge of \$1 per month per light standard.

Either charge is in addition to the rates in Part III.

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IV. ADDITIONAL FACILITIES CHARGE, cont'd

- B. Where the Cooperative is required to furnish underground service to metal or concrete poles in residential subdivisions, Member may:
1. Make a lump sum payment of \$200 per light standard, or
 2. Pay a monthly charge of \$2 per month per light standard.

Either charge is in addition to the rate charges in Part III.

- C. Where the Cooperative is required to furnish underground service to metal or concrete poles in areas other than residential subdivisions, the lump sum payment or monthly charge, as applicable, will be based upon actual costs of installation.
- D. Where the Cooperative is required to furnish energy only, the charge will be 5.41 cents per kWh plus applicable power cost adjustment and environmental cost adjustment charges.

V. POWER COST ADJUSTMENT

The above energy charges shall be increased as determined under the Power Cost Adjustment Clause PCA-BE.

VI. TERMS OF PAYMENT

The above rates are net, the gross rate being 5% higher on the bill. In the event that the current monthly bill is not paid within twenty (20) days from the date of the bill, the gross rate shall apply.

VII. ENVIRONMENTAL COST ADJUSTMENT

The above energy charges shall be increased as determined under the Environmental Cost Adjustment Clause ECA-BE.
